



# Santa Cruz Island

**Camp Out, Snorkel, Kayak, Hike**  
**July 23<sup>rd</sup>-26<sup>th</sup>, 2010**

**Begin** with a beautiful one hour boat ride escorted by playful dolphins, the wind in your hair and the sea all around you. The excitement builds as we spot land in the distance -our new, essentially uninhabited island home. Spend a relaxing weekend at Scorpion Ranch, in a protected canyon with towering eucalyptus trees on one of the jewels of Channel Islands National Park-Santa Cruz Island, home of the Island Fox.

**Discover** what California was like during an earlier time as we experience pristine, breathtaking scenery and explore a historic Californian island ranch. Glide across the shoreline in a kayak exploring giant sea caves or find a secluded beach to bathe in the sun.

**Amenities:** Camping conditions are primitive. Sites are equipped with picnic tables, water and pit toilets. No trash containers are provided; campers must pack out their own trash. No campfires are permitted due to the high fire danger. The campground is located 1-1/2 mile from the landing over mostly flat, somewhat rocky-irregular terrain.

**What to Bring:** Tent, sleeping bag and pad, blanket, sun shower, food and cooking utensils, potluck dish for Saturday night, water container, water flavoring packets, day pack, hiking boots, sunscreen, swim suit, snorkel, mask and the ten essentials. Label all gear with your name and Santa Cruz Island. Pack everything within gear bags, no loose items. **PACK LIGHTLY** since you will be carrying in all your equipment 1-1/2 miles to our camp site. Try to pack the most minimal amount for a good time! Treat this like a backpacking trip. If you are packing fuel, label it with your name and island.

**What Not to Bring:** Items weighing more than 45lbs each, including ice chest, no items stored in paper bags, carts or wagons, no loose gear or glass containers. Take only what you need, Pack it in-Pack it OUT.

**Kayak Use:** We will have access to several single kayaks on Saturday and Sunday to be shared by everyone on the trip. Please see the video demonstration at the Channel Islands Kayak Center if you intend to use a kayak.

**Time of Departure:** The boat leaves at 8 am on Friday, July 23rd. You must be at the dock **ONE HOUR BEFORE DEPARTURE** at 7 am. Don't be late. The return boat leaves the island at 3:00pm on Monday, July 26<sup>th</sup> and arrives in Ventura Harbor at approximately 5:00 pm. If due to a conflict, you need to arrive or depart other than with the group, see Gray to arrange your passage. The ferry company services the island two times every day.

**Directions:** Transportation to Santa Cruz Island is operated by Island Packers located in Ventura Harbor.

**From San Diego:** Take the 101 north to Ventura, exit at Victoria Avenue. Turn Left on Victoria. Proceed 1/2 mile to Olivas Park Drive, right. Olivas Park Drive becomes Spinnaker Drive. Look for the Island Packers sign at 1691 Spinnaker Drive, Suite 105B.

**From Santa Barbara:** Take the 101 south to Ventura. Exit at Seaward, make a right. Then turn left onto Harbor Blvd. Make a right onto Spinnaker Drive. Look for the Island Packers sign at 1691 Spinnaker Drive, Suite 105B.

**Sign up early, space is limited.** Your reservation and full payment reserves your spot. Cancellations for full refunds must be received no later than Friday, July 9<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
