From the Gamble House Website: “The Gamble House in Pasadena, California, is an outstanding example of American Arts and Crafts style architecture. The house and furnishings were designed by architects Charles and Henry Greene in 1908 for David and Mary Gamble of the Procter & Gamble Company.

The house, designated a National Historic Landmark in 1978, is owned by the City of Pasadena and operated by the University of Southern California.

One-hour docent-led tours are available to the public Thursday-Sunday. Tours begin at 11:30am Thurs-Fri and 12noon Sat-Sun.
