Don't miss this scenic road trip, riding through gently curving, country roads, to Julian, California. The Palm Springs Chapter of Great Outdoors will meet with fellow Great Outdoor members from all five chapters and motorcyclists for an overnight outing. See the gold rush town and browse the quaint shops and art galleries of historic Julian.

Julian, CA, is a mountain getaway in the beautiful Cuyamaca Mountains. Take a step back in time to the days of Julian's beginning rooted in the 1870's gold rush. Get away from the hectic city life ... discover Julian, where gold was discovered ... the original historic buildings ... sample Julian's famous apple pies ... hike ... camp amid oaks and pines. We will be camping overnight at William Heise County Park.

The purpose of this outing is designed to meet the members of Great Outdoors, who actually desire to ride a motorcycle to an overnight destination. If there are enough interested bikers are, then we can plan for future events. For those that just want to visit with us, for the day, feel free to stop by. Let us know who you are.

Campsite fees are \$19 per site - maximum of one tent (up to 10' x 10') and six people per site. Pay your campsite fee directly to the park upon arrival. If you are not camping and wish to enter the park to visit, the park charges a \$3 per person day use fee - again, pay that fee directly to the park.

Itinerary

Wednesday, May 5, 2010

- Travel from your hometown directly to Julian, CA. Check in at your campsite 2 PM, set up camp. Meeting area is campsite #38, located in Area 2

- Ride with us from Cathedral City, CA. Maps will be distributed the day of the ride, to each bike. Ride time is approx 3 hours from Cathedral City, CA, to Julian, CA (approximately 100 miles each way)

- 10am Leave from Revivals at HWY 111 and Cathedral Canyon
.....Several stops at check points along the way for fuel and resting, as needed
- 2 PM Julian, CA check in at William Heise County Park, Campsite #38 (area 2)
.....Free time in Julian
- 6 pm..... Meet at (location to be determined) for dinner
- 8 or 9 pm campfire (if applicable)

Thursday, May 6, 2010

- 9 am Breakfast at Julian Café on Main Street
- 10 amfree time in Julian
- 1 pmcheck out of campsite and return home.

For bikes returning to Cathedral City, CA: Leave from park entrance at 1 pm with stops along the way for fuel and rest as needed, either as a group, or on your own.

Safety First. Remember to pack your bike safely with your camping gear. Bring only what you need for an overnight stay.
