San Diego Great Outdoors Presents Anza-Borrego Wild Flower Tour Palm Canyon Camp Out March 26th-29th, 2010

Anza-Borrego Desert State Park is the largest state park in California. Five-hundred miles of dirt roads, 12 wilderness areas and miles of hiking trails provide visitors with an unparalleled opportunity to experience the wonders of the California Desert. The park is named after Spanish explorer Juan Bautista de Anza and the Spanish name borrego, or bighorn sheep.

The park features washes, wildflowers, palm groves, cacti and sweeping vistas. Visitors may also have the chance to see roadrunner, golden eagles, kit foxes, mule deer and bighorn sheep as well as iguanas, chuckwallas and the red diamond rattlesnake.

This years wildflower tour might be the best ever. Anza Borrego has received a record rain fall, temperatures are heating up and the flowers are ready to bud, bloom and burst. If you have never witness the desert in bloom, this is the time.

Location - Directions

The Park is located on the eastern side of San Diego County, with portions extending east into Imperial County and north into Riverside County. It is about a two-hour drive from San Diego, Riverside, and Palm Springs.

Many visitors approach from the east or west via Highways S22 and 78. From the coast, these highways descend from the heights of the Peninsular range of mountains with spectacular views of the great bowl of the Colorado Desert. Highway S2 enters the park from the south off of Interstate 8.

Breakfast will be provided on Saturday morning and we will host a potluck on Saturday night, so please provide a dish to server 8-10 fellow campers.

Be prepared for all weather conditions, bring appropriate clothing, shoe's and wet gear. Do not forget the ten essentials. There are quarter showers a short walk from our campsite, flush toilets nearby and fresh water.

Please bring 2 bundles of wood for our campfire.

Parking is limited so carpooling is encouraged. The outing fee does not include entry or overflow parking fee's governed by the State Parks. We have reserved sites#93, 95, 97 & 99. Reservations are under Daniel Castro/San Diego Great Outdoors
