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One of the most beautiful Southern California mountain destinations, the Serrano campground is ideally located near the lake with large sites. Great hiking and bicycle paths right from the camp. The Discovery Nature Center is walking distance and close to restaurants and small boutique stores in the town of [Big Bear](#).

We have 7 adjacent spacious premium campsites with lake views and overflow parking very close. Facilities include fire rings, picnic tables, flush toilets and showers at the campground. Room for 7 RV's (no hookups) and 25 tents. Pets allowed on leash. Attractions: Alpine pedal path, Woodland Trail, Cougar Crest Trail, narrated boat tour.

Serrano Campground is located in a mountain setting within the San Bernardino National Forest near Big Bear Lake. Address: 40650 North Shore Lane (Highway 38), Fawnskin, CA 92333.

Directions: From I-10 in Redlands, CA, take State Hwy 30/330 north to State Hwy 18 in Running Springs. Continue east on Highway 18 at Bear Dam. Go straight, do not cross Dam. Hwy 18 becomes Hwy 38 at Dam. Continue on 38 to Serrano Campground sign on right side of Hwy 38 (about 2 miles E of Fawnskin). GPS coordinates: 34.26139, -116.91944 or N 34 15.683 W 116 55.166
